

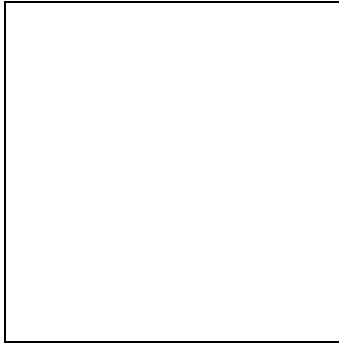

NO CRATING/EXPENS ALLOWED INSIDE THE SOUTH EXHIBITION BUILDING #3 AND SMALL BUILDING # 1.

 Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal/external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Best Of Breed Competition

AWARDS OF MERIT

At a National Specialty, the number of quality dogs in competition often far exceeds the number of top awards available. The judge may choose only one Best of Breed and one Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed. The awarding of an Award of Merit acknowledges that this animal was under consideration for Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed. The judge is indicating his/her recognition of an animal that would, on another day, merit a top award. The Rhodesian Ridgeback Club of the United States, Inc. allows for ten Awards of Merit to be presented in addition to Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed. The judge may, at his/her discretion, award all or none of the Rosettes. Each entrant receiving an AOM will receive a Gear/Tote Bag with Logo and Hand crafted wood laser engraved item. Receiving an Award of Merit is indeed a significant honor.

Additional Classes

Involving Single Dogs

Veteran Dog/Bitch: For Dogs and Bitches 7 years of age and over. Neutered Dogs and Spayed bitches may compete in this class.

Field Championship Dog/Bitch: For Dogs and Bitches at least 6 months of age having achieved an AKC Field Championship or RRFCH title. Dogs/ Bitches may **NOT** be spayed or neutered. No ILP registered animals in this class.

Altered Dog/Bitch - Open to Altered Dogs and Spayed Bitches; not open to ILP registered animals. Winners of these classes will **NOT** be eligible to compete for Best of Breed Competition. This class will be judged after Veteran Dog or Bitch respectively.

Non-Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dogs

As the judge's decision in the Non Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog/bitch, no one of the dogs/bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best Of Breed by virtue of having won these classes

Stud Dog: For Stud Dog and two to four of the Get. Stud Dog must be entered in The Stud Dog Class and must be shown with their Get. The owner of the Stud Dog need not be the owner of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the Standard for its Breed. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best Of Breed competition or some other Non Regular class. The entry must be marked in the additional class on the entry form.

Brood Bitch: The same as Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

Brace Class: (For Two dogs, of the same breed with one owner in common) The dogs comprising a Brace **Must Be Named** at the time of entry. If a dog, which is part of the Brace is not entered in another class, it must be entered for "Brace Only" under additional Class and full particulars given on the entry form. If more than one brace is entered by the same identical owner, each entrant must be designated "Brace1", "Brace 2", etc.

Best Veteran In Specialty Best Of Opposite Sex To Best Veteran In Specialty

The regular breed judge will judge this class, after Best of Breed is completed. The winners of the three dog/bitch Veterans classes will compete for Best Veteran and Best Of Opposite Sex to Best Veteran unless directly or indirectly defeated, i.e. the Veteran 9-11 dog goes Best of Breed he would also go Best Veteran. The three winners of the opposite sex to the Best Veteran will compete for Best of Opposite Sex to Best Veteran In Specialty
