Trophies will be offered for 1-4 in each class, BOB and 1st in Kennel/Breeder Stakes.

ROLL CALL: 7:30 A.M.

Entries will NOT be acknowledged by mail.

Eligible Breeds and Registry:

Only purebred Rhodesian Ridgebacks may be entered in the regular stakes.
All entries in the regular stakes shall be individually registered with the American Kennel Club, the Federation Cynologique Internationale, an ASFA-recognized foreign or ASFA Board approved registry.

STAKES OFFERED

OPEN: Any eligible Rhodesian Ridgeback, excluding ASFA Field Champions of record.

FIELD CHAMPION: Any Rhodesian Ridgeback ASFA Field Champion.

VETERAN: Any eligible Rhodesian Ridgeback whose age is at least six years.

SINGLE STAKES: (limited to 10 entries): open to eligible Rhodesian Ridgeback including those disqualified to run in other stakes

Non-Regular Stakes Offered:

KENNEL STAKE: For two hounds of the same breed, designated at the time of entry, entered in one of the regular stakes, owned and kenneled by the same person.

BREEDER STAKE: For two hounds of the same breed, designated at the time of entry, entered in one of the regular stakes, bred by the same individual.

NOTE: An owner-breeder may have more than one entry in the kennel or breeder stakes as long as the two hounds comprising each entry are properly identified at the time of the entry. A hound may be a part of only one kennel and one breeder entry.

BEST IN FIELD WILL NOT BE OFFERED

All entries must be one year of age or older on the day of the trial.

Stakes will be split into flights by public random draw if the entry in any regular stake is 20 or more.

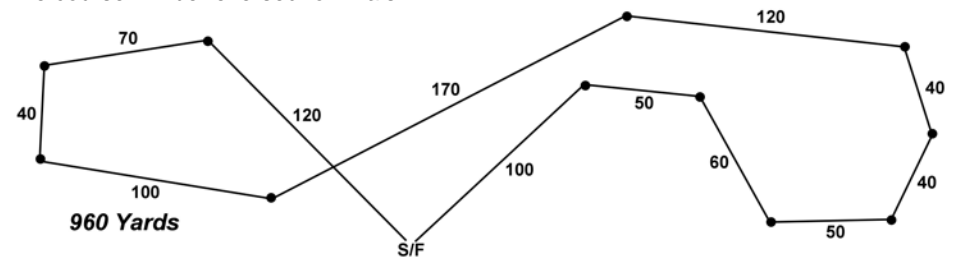
Bitches in season, hounds with breed disqualifications, and lame hounds will be excused.

Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched.

Battery powered, continuous loop lure machine will be used.

The lure will consist of plastic bags.

The course will be reversed for finals.

Voice of America Park

From host hotel:

Turn right out of the driveway onto Kings Island Drive, go 1.5 miles to Western Row Road, turn right on Western Row Road, go 5 miles to Cox Road, turn right on Cox Road, go 1/2 mile to VOA Park Drive, turn right into the park. **See In the Park below.** **Note:** Western Row Road turns into Tylersville Road at Innovation Way, about 1 mile from Kings Island Drive.

From the north on I-71:

Exit at Kings Mills Road (exit 25), turn left, go to Kings Island Drive (about 1/2 mile), turn right. The host hotel will be on your right about 1/2 mile. Follow the directions above from the hotel driveway.

From the south on I-71:

Exit at Western Row Road (exit 23/24), turn left on Western Row Road, follow the directions above (when you turn left, you will be at the intersection of Kings Island Drive and Western Row Road).

From the north on I-75:

Exit at Tylersville Road (exit 22), turn left, go 1/2 mile to Cox Road, turn left, go 1/2 mile to VOA Park Drive, turn right into the park. **See In the Park below.**

From the south on I-75:

Exit at Tylersville Road (exit 22), turn right, go 4/10 mile to Cox Road, turn left, go 1/2 mile to VOA Park Drive, turn right into the park. **See In the Park below.**

In the park:

Go 1/10 mile to the first access road, turn right. Shortly after the access road curves to the left (about 4/10 mile), there will be a shelter on the left where we will roll-call. The trial field is north of the shelter. The JC field is straight ahead (east) about 100 yards and to the right. There is parking to the right (south) opposite the shelter, parking straight ahead about 100 yards on the left opposite the JC field, or you may park along the access road that borders the east side of the trial field (turn left at the shelter). If you park along the access road, pull completely off the road - either pull in, back in, or parallel to the road. Stay close to the road but be sure to leave the road clear since others will be using the park and may need to get past on the access road. The field is 20 minutes from the host hotel.

- The field is rolling terrain. The entire 300 + acres are fenced.
- No camping allowed.
- No water is available at the field.
- Food will be available to purchase for lunch See order form.
